

Enhancement:

1. Display informative messages regarding IPv6 usage within rules. When users try to remove an IP address from an active IPv6 interface, the system will display usage message regarding the interface. This enhancement ensures users promptly understand interface dependencies, preventing unintended disruptions during IP address modifications.

Bug Fixes:

- 1. When an interface is actively being used by DHCP Configuration, it should not allow changes to interfaces type. This prevents potential disruptions in the network due to interface modifications conflicting with DHCP settings in use.
- 2. Fixed the issue where the 4in6 type iptunnel was incorrectly displaying in the interface tab. This fix ensures that the interface tab accurately reflects valid information.
- 3. Addressed the problem where check boxes in mail settings were unclickable, allowing users to properly interact with and modify these settings.
- 4. Fixed the unclear notifications related to the start/stop of the SNMP (Simple Network Management Protocol) service
