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Enhancement:

- 1. Moved the Trusted Domain tab to the Browsing Policy section for improved arrangement and accessibility.
- 2. Simplified the dashboard display for easier understanding of system performance, making it more user-friendly.

Bug Fixes:

- 1. Removed log days limits from the Misc Options value, allowing users to set the value to 0 or any desired number based on their requirements.
- 2. Fixed a scenario where if both IPv4 and IPv6 were present in an interface but there were no rules for the IPv6 interface and no use of that IPv6, it now allows the removal of the specific IPv6 from that interface.
- 3. Resolved an issue where editing IPv6 VLAN was not permitted; now users can edit and modify IPv6 VLAN configurations as needed.
- 4. Rectified an issue with dynamic routing tables where they were displaying errors instead of properly formatted data; now routing tables will display in the correct format.
- 5. Added validation for IP Tunnel to prevent the use of the same IP address for both IPv4 and IPv6 configurations.
- 6. Improved the display of ARP/IPv6 Neighbor field messages in debug network, ensuring accurate and valid response messages are shown.
- 7. Restricted the usage of duplicate VLAN tag IDs to prevent conflicts and ensure proper VLAN configuration.
